

Mayor's Message

Hello, Bonjour Gravelbourg!

As we welcome Spring 2025, here's a recap of some key happenings from Winter 2024.

• MEETING WITH OUR M.P.

Council had the opportunity to meet with our Member of Parliament, Mr. Jeremy Patzer, for over an hour to discuss important issues - most notably our housing and infrastructure needs. Mr. Patzer was in town to recognize the incredible work of the Gravelbourg Cares Shuttle Service team and to inaugurate their new garage. Following the ribbon-cutting ceremony, he kindly accepted Council's invitation to meet. I look forward to many more discussions and collaborations with him in the future.

FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

As part of the Net Zero Community Accelerator Initiative, the Town of Gravelbourg's Environmental Advisory Committee has been working with Eco-West to pursue two significant funding opportunities: FCM's Sustainable Municipal Buildings program and the federal Climate Ready Infrastructure Service (CRIS) program. I'm pleased to announce that our

CRIS application, an options and pre-feasibility study to explore using the Gravelbourg Aquifer to develop a district energy system, has been approved!

TRANSFER STATION UPDATE

Council has eliminated the punch card system and associated fees. We are still exploring ways to make the Transfer Station more accessible while ensuring security at a feasible cost. If you have an unused punch card to reimburse, please return it to the Town Office by April 30.

STRATEGIC PLANNING INITIATIVE

Council has retained Matthewson & Co. to assist in developing a strategic plan for the town. Thank you to everyone who completed the Quality of Life and Business surveys. Your input will help Council prioritize the issues that matter most to residents.

• INFRASTRUCTURE REHABILITATION

The Town of Gravelbourg has been working closely with <u>Associated</u> <u>Engineering</u> on plans to make necessary upgrades to critical infrastructure in a fiscally responsible manner. Stay tuned for updates on the sanitary sewer and water main rehabilitation project in the coming weeks.

Town Council remains committed to improving communication with residents, and we will continue to provide updates like this to keep you informed. DIRT 2 DREAMS AGM - One year ago, Dirt 2 Dreams began a journey to support community-driven projects, starting with a vision to raise funds for local initiatives. Spring is in the air, and we are shifting gears to the warm season work. Here are some ways you can help us keep Gravelbourg beautiful!

- STREET SWEEPING is starting soon. Please pay attention to signage.
 Make sure to park your vehicle out of the way when your street is scheduled to be cleaned.
- 2. DRAINAGE works best when catch basins are clear of leaves and snow. Public Works has many operations to oversee and attend to, and we are always grateful when residents take the time to keep the catch basins adjacent to their properties free of debris.
- 3. BOULEVARDS look most beautiful when they are well-maintained. As the soil wakes back up and the growing season begins, Public Works takes pride in maintaining numerous green spaces throughout town. We truly appreciate your assistance in keeping grass boulevards cut, resurfaced boulevards weed-free, and re-purposed boulevards neat and tidy.

Sport, Culture & Recreation

We have exciting updates to share with you as we prepare for the upcoming fantastic season of recreational activities. From facility improvements to new programs, here's what's happening in the rec community!

1. New Dugouts for the Middle Ball Diamond

Town Council approved the **Dugout Replacement Project** for the middle ball diamond! The project (total estimated cost of **\$9,000**) will ensure the replacement of both dugouts, creating a better environment for players and spectators.

This project is made possible through the combined efforts of the **Town** of **Gravelbourg**, the **Minor Ball Association**, Dirt 2 Dreams, and local sponsors. We look forward to completing the dugouts for the upcoming season and enhancing our ball diamond for all to enjoy!

2. Swim Club

Swim Club Registration is now open! The 2025 season starts May 5th. The program will run on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

Swim Club offers the following registration groups:

Administration

It has been another busy year so far in administration as we work diligently to keep all systems running and respond to every one of your inquiries.

1. TRANSFER STATION spring hours start April 2. Council eliminated disposal fees to make the transfer station more accessible to residents. Current hours are as follows:

Wednesdays: 11:00AM-7:00PM

Saturday: 9:30AM-4:30PM

- 2. PUNCH CARD REFUNDS are in the works. Due to the administrative labour involved, these refunds will be processed in batches. Please drop your unused transfer station punch card off at the Town Office by April 30.
- 3. TAX ASSESSMENTS The Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency assesses properties based on multiple factors. Information to help you understand your assessment is available on the SAMA website.

Should you consider your property wrongly assessed, you may file an <u>appeal</u>. Information regarding the appeal process can be found on the back page of your property assessment.

Here's a look at some of the current and upcoming events and initiatives:

- 1. **COMMUNITY BUILDERS WORKSHOP** Gravelbourg is one of only 5 communities in Saskatchewan selected by the <u>Saskatchewan</u> <u>Economic Development Alliance</u> to host the *Positive Pathways to Rural and Small Town Prosperity* workshop. Delivered by internationally renowned rural community builder <u>Peter Kenyon</u>, the workshop will bring regional leaders and community champions together for a full day of collaborative activities designed to give participants the tools to drive community change. The full-day workshop is \$30 for Gravelbourg residents and includes a catered lunch, snacks, and refreshments. <u>Register before April 23 to secure your spot!</u>
- 2. TRANSETTE DRIVERS NEEDED! We are experiencing a shortage of drivers for our local handi-bus serving residents at the Pioneer Villa, Bon Ami, and Foyer d'Youville. The commitment is minimal as drivers are generally scheduled on a monthly rotation with an average of 2-4 hours

per week at \$15/hour. Please call the administrative assistant at 306-648-3301 Ext. 5 for more information.

3. **DUTCH ELM DISEASE** is a fatal tree disease caused by a fungus spread by elm bark beetles. As the weather warms, the beetles become more active and are attracted to fresh cuts on trees. Pruning in spring and summer increases the chances of an infection and puts your elms at risk. **Elm tree pruning is prohibited April 1 - August 31.**
